YEAR 4 NATURE WALK TO ABBEY FIELDS – THURSDAY 22ND JUNE 2017

As part of our learning challenge (Who would live in a place like this?), we will be continuing our study of habitats and classifying different living creatures in Science. To link with this, we plan to visit Abbey Fields for a nature walk, during which we will be observing and identifying species of local plants and animals. At the park, we will be met by Community Ranger Laura Smith, who will be guiding us through various activities.

The trip will take place on the morning of Thursday 22nd June, with both Year 4 classes walking to Abbey Fields at 9.00am. We will return to school in time for lunch. Therefore, please send your child with a packed lunch or expect school meals as normal.

On the day of the trip, it is essential that all children be dressed appropriately for the weather. All children should wear suitable outdoor footwear please. In case of warm weather, please ensure that your child has sun cream, a hat and plenty of water. In case of rain, please ensure that your child has a waterproof coat. Apart from this, children will be expected to wear full school uniform please.

We already have permission for your child to participate (via the school activities parental consent form), so this letter is for information only. *If we have not received a completed parental consent form from you, you will have been notified by text.
