YEAR 6 TRIPS TO BLACK COUNTRY LIVING MUSEUM AND COVENTRY TRANSPORT MUSEUM

As I am sure you are aware, Year 6 will not now be visiting London on 4th July. To replace this trip, and to ensure the children have a memorable end to their time here at St John's, we have replaced this trip with two days out as follows:

Black Country Living Museum

We will be visiting the Black Country Living Museum on Thursday 13th July. We will have the opportunity to consider what life was like for children across different time periods, taking part in engaging and hands-on activities, including taking lessons in a 1912 school classroom and the chance to go on some Victorian fairground rides. We will leave school promptly at 9.00am and will return to school in time for the end of the day. Most of the day will be spent outside, so please check the weather forecast on the day so that you know whether to send your child with a waterproof coat or with a sun hat and sun cream!

Coventry Transport Museum

On Wednesday 19th July, we will be going to Coventry to visit the transport museum while the rest of the school move up to their new classes for the day. We will be leaving school after registration and will return by the end of the day. The day out will be led by Mrs Kirk, who has been teaching the children on Thursday afternoons this year.

For both trips, the children should wear school uniform please. They will also need to bring a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks please). If you are entitled to free school meals and would like a school packed lunch, please speak to Mrs Morris or Mrs Weir in the office.

The total cost of both trips will be £30.00, which will cover travel by coach, entrance to the Black Country Living Museum, activities, insurance and the opportunity to choose a treat from the sweet shop at the Black Country Living Museum. **If you have already paid for the London trip, we will automatically transfer your payment to cover the cost of the two trips. If you have not already paid for London, we would welcome a voluntary contribution of £30.00.** Preferred method of payment is ParentPay. *Please note that if we don't receive sufficient contributions, the trip may not be able to go ahead. If you are having difficulty paying, please speak to Mr Barrow or the office staff in confidence, and we can discuss either a payment plan or a reduced contribution.*
