Dear Parents and Carers,

RESIDENTIAL TRIP FOR YEAR 6 2019/20 (CURRENT YEAR 5) – JUNE 2020

We are planning a Year 6 residential visit for our current Year 5 pupils to take place between Monday 1st and Friday 5th June 2020. The venue for the visit will be Condoover Hall in Shropshire, where fully trained and qualified instructors, with the support of school staff, will provide instruction in a full programme of activities in a safe, controlled and secure environment. Typical activities include canoeing, climbing, high ropes, archery, fencing and orienteering. More information on Condoover Hall can be found at <https://www.condoverhall.com/>.

We expect the cost of the trip to be around £410.00 per pupil: this may vary slightly depending on the level of interest. This will cover coach travel to and from Condoover Hall, full board accommodation, all instruction and activities, and travel insurance. **We are asking for an initial deposit of £40 per child to be received by Friday 15th February 2019 please.** This will secure your child's place and enable us to finalise numbers and the contributions from parents/carers necessary for the trip to go ahead. **A second deposit of £60 will be required by Friday 12th April 2019.** Both deposits are non-refundable. Our preferred method of payment is ParentPay; alternatively, please send a cheque or cash into school. The balance of contributions will be required by mid-March 2020 and this can be paid in instalments. In addition, children may wish to bring some spending money up to a maximum of £10.


If finances are a factor in your decision regarding your child's participation in the visit, please speak in confidence to a member of staff in the office or your child's teacher, and we will endeavour to find a solution. The William Edwards Educational Charity exists to enable all children attending Kenilworth schools to access curriculum activities. The Edwards Charity has been very supportive of similar visits in the past so we would encourage you to make an application for funding and would be happy to assist you with this. Please speak to the office for further information.

On Monday 21st January 2019, we will be holding an information meeting for parents and carers of our current Year 5 children to provide more details of the visit. The meeting will take place at 3.30pm, and we hope as many parents as possible will attend.

Please complete the attached slip and return it to school by Friday 15th February. If you require any additional information or have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to Mrs Tennant or the school office.
