YEAR 6 – WW2 WALK – RE-SCHEDULED TO FRIDAY 15TH MARCH 2019

You will have previously received a letter advising you that, for our topic on WW2, we would like to give the children the opportunity to investigate the impacts of the war on their local area. We have now re-scheduled this to **the morning of Friday 15th March**. We will be taking the children on a tour around important sites in Kenilworth. We will visit St John's Church, Abbey End and Abbey Fields. We will discuss the impact of the war on Kenilworth and explore some air raid sites. The walk will coincide with Comic Relief. We are asking the children to wear red for Red Nose Day, so will not expect them to wear school uniform on the walk.
