

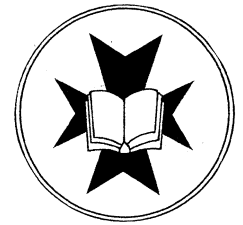

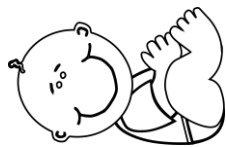
Thanks again for your positivity and support during Ofsted. Have a lovely long weekend.
