

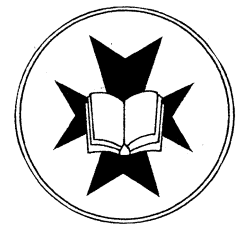

If your child(ren) attend Out of School Club and you'd like them to have a photo, please also let the office know so that we can make sure that the Out of School Club staff know who to take through to the Hall.*
