## Our Theme is Good to be me!

### Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be making relationships and learning to develop our self-confidence and self-awareness by working alongside and with each other.

We are learning to:

- Seek out others to share our experiences.
- Express feelings such as sad, happy, cross, scared and worried.
- Express our own preferences and interests.

### Maths Focus

We will be developing our skill in using and applying number and exploring shape, space and measure in everyday situations and tasks, as well as in games linked to our topic.

We are learning to:

- Recite some number names in sequence
- Use some language of quantity, such as 'more' and 'a lot'
- Notice simple shapes and patterns in pictures

### Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring and using a wide range of media and materials to create props to enhance our imaginative play and learning.

We are learning to:

- Experiment with blocks, colours and marks.
- Begin to make-believe by pretending.

### Understanding the World

Through our topic, we will be learning about ourselves, our families and each other. We will be finding out about our similarities and differences and the things that make us unique!

We are learning to:

- Learn that we have similarities and differences that connect us to, and distinguish us from, others.
- Notice detailed features of objects in our environment.

### English Focus

We will be developing our early reading and writing skills in everyday literacy activities. We will also be developing our love of books, songs and rhymes in our play.

We are learning to:

- Repeats words or phrases from familiar stories.
- Distinguish between the different marks we make.

### Physical Development

We will be using large and small construction toys and tools to develop our moving and handling skills. We will be developing our understanding of health and wellbeing by learning to transport and handle toys and tools safely.

We are learning to:

- Show control in holding and using jugs to pour, hammers, books and mark-making tools.
- Begin to be independent in self-care, but still often need adult support.

### Communication and Language

In speaking and listening games and activities, we will be developing our speaking, listening and understanding skills.

We are learning to:

- Show interest in play with sounds, songs and rhymes.
- Respond to simple instructions, e.g. to get or put away an object.
- Use language as a powerful means of widening contact, sharing feelings, experiences and thoughts.
