Communication and Literacy

In games and activities, we will be continuing to show interest in play with sounds, songs and rhymes, as well as developing our understanding of more complex sentences. We will also be showing understanding of prepositions such as 'under', 'on top' and 'behind'.

Literacy

We will be learning to distinguish between the different marks we make and giving meaning to marks as we draw and paint. We will be continuing to develop our writing using some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning, representing some sounds correctly and in sequence.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be developing our self-confidence and self-awareness by expressing our own preferences and interests and learning to respect those of others when playing and communicating about our own home and community.

Maths

Shape, space and measure work will include identifying and describing simple shapes and patterns in pictures and talking about the shapes of everyday objects. We will be learning about ordering two or three items by length or height, and using everyday language related to time.

Physical Development

We will be continuing to develop our moving and handling skills, showing control in holding and using jugs to pour, hammers, books and mark-making tools. We will be continuing to use one-handed tools and equipment, and beginning to use anticlockwise movement, as well as retracing vertical lines. We will be developing our use of the three-finger (tripod) grip to hold writing tools effectively in order to imitate drawing simple shapes such as circles and lines and to form recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.

Understanding the World

Through our topic, we will be learning about the natural world and using technology. We will be learning about plants and the environment and all of the minibeasts that inhabit our garden.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning about colour and how colours can be changed, as well as exploring what happens when we mix colours. We will also be exploring selecting appropriate resources and adapting work where necessary, selecting tools and techniques needed to shape, assemble and join materials that we are using.
