Numeracy Focus

We are learning to:

- Count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number.
- Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.
- Use quantities and objects to add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.

Creativity

We are learning to:

- Use what we have learnt about media and materials in original ways, thinking about uses and purposes.
- Safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques.

Knowledge and Understanding including Science, ICT and Humanities

We are learning to:

- Talk about the features of our immediate environment and how environments might differ from one another.
- Select and use technology for particular purposes.

Literacy Focus

We are learning to:

- Use our phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match spoken sounds.
- Write simple sentences which can be read by ourselves and others.
- Use our phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately.
- Discuss with others about what we have read, improving our comprehension skills.

- Little Red Riding Hood

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We are learning to:

- Talk about our ideas and choose the resources we need for our chosen activities.
