Knowledge and Understanding including Science, ICT and Humanities

- We will be describing the different things that people in our own community do to help maintain the area we live in.
- We will be finding out about and using a range of everyday technology.
- We will be selecting appropriate applications that support an identified need, e.g. in deciding how best to make a record of a special event in our lives.
- We will be continuing to practise our ball skills. We will also be practising hard for our Early Years Sports Morning on Friday 14th July!

Our Theme is People Who Help Us

Numeracy Focus

We will be learning to:

- Use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money to compare quantities and objects and to solve problems.
- Recognise, create and describe patterns.
- Explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.
- Solidify our knowledge of numbers, place value and estimation.

Literacy Focus

- We will be using our phonic knowledge to write words in ways that match our spoken sounds.
- We will be writing some irregular common words.
- We will be writing simple sentences which can be read by us and others.
- We will be spelling phonically regular words of more than one syllable as well as many irregular but high frequency words.
- We will be using key narrative features in our writing.
- Our special focus is to compose extended pieces of topic-based writing.

Creativity

- We will be singing songs, making music and dancing, and experimenting with ways of changing them.
- We will be safely using and exploring a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.
- We will be practicing for our class assembly (Friday 7th July) which will include singing, dancing and drama!

Ways you can help at home...

- Sequencing numbers to 20 and beyond.
- Lots of practical problem solving for doubling and halving.
- Help children recite their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Discuss and share language about comparing sizes, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money.
- Practise all the phonics sounds and tricky words.
- Keep up the reading at home!
- Discuss different jobs and their importance in the community, particularly people who help us, e.g. policemen, firemen, doctors, dentists, nurses etc.
